



NEIGHBORHOOD CLEANUP EVENTS TERMS & CONDITIONS

- To participate in the event, at the time of check-in, residents are required to provide their online registration confirmation code, proof of identification (California Driver's License) and current City of Brentwood utility bill.
- Residents are to arrive at event check-in only during their selected registration timeframe, or they may be turned away from participating in the event.
- No hazardous wastes of any kind will be accepted. If these items are brought, residents will be required to take them back for proper disposal. Brentwood residents can dispose of hazardous waste items at the Delta Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility in Pittsburg (www.ddsd.org).
- If items brought to the event exceed 2 cubic yards, fees may be charged to the resident's City Utility Billing account based on fees listed in the City's Cost Allocation Plan (CAP).
- Residents shall wear closed-end shoes while at the facility.
- Children and pets must remain in cars during the event.
- Observe all speed limit and traffic signs, as well as City staff directives, to ensure a safe and orderly event for everyone.
