HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- Register online at www.brentwoodca.gov/cleanup.
- Have your confirmation number, your City of Brentwood utility bill and your identification (driver's license) available at event check-in.
- Wear closed-end shoes. They are required for safety reasons.
- Children/pets must remain in cars when materials are dropped off.

WHAT YOU CAN DROP OFF

- Dispose of up to 2 cubic yards (about one (1) pickup truck load or a small utility trailer load) of your unwanted household items including cardboard, furniture, mattresses, TVs, computers and other electronic waste, general waste, appliances, metal, wood and yard waste and tires (maximum of 4). Fees may be charged to your Utility Billing account if items exceed 2 cubic yards.
- **Recycling** – When loading please separate these items for recycling: appliances, electronic waste, mattresses, metal, clean wood (unpainted, no particle board), cardboard, yard waste and passenger tires only (max. 4 tires).
- **Remove Batteries** – Please be sure all batteries are removed from devices prior to bringing to the event. They are considered hazardous waste. See below for proper disposal.
- All other items will be disposed of in the general waste area. See the photograph on the next page of this flyer for the different drop-off areas.

2301 Elkins Way**

- Directions: From Brentwood Boulevard, go East on Sunset Road, then North on Elkins Way. Continue to the end of the road, then turn left.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No hazardous waste (propane tanks, helium tanks, batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, paint, oil, e.g., motor or cooking oil, aerosol containers or pesticides) will be accepted.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Brentwood residents can use the free household hazardous waste drop off every Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Delta Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility at 2550 Pittsburg-Antioch Highway, Pittsburg.
