

**APPLICATION PACKET FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE
CITY OF BRENTWOOD PUBLIC FINANCING AUTHORITY FOR THE
INNOVATION CENTER ENHANCED INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING
DISTRICT AND BRENTWOOD BOULEVARD ENHANCED
INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING DISTRICT**

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Public Financing Authority (“PFA”) members are appointed by majority approval of the City Council, to serve two-year terms. Examples of typical PFA member duties include: approval of an Infrastructure Financing Plan (and any proposed amendments to that Plan), and the consideration of issuance of bonds to finance the projects defined by the Infrastructure Financing Plan. More information about Enhanced Infrastructure Finances Districts (EIFDs) and duties of PFA members for each EIFD may be found at: <https://www.brentwoodca.gov/gov/cd/ed/eifds.asp>

- The PFA board meets annually and as necessary to perform the responsibilities under the EIFD Law.
- Applicants must be a full-time resident, registered voter, employee, or representative of a non-profit entity, educational institution, business owner and/or other corporate citizen within the City of Brentwood.
- The City Council may prioritize the selection of Applicants that currently reside in Brentwood, and have an educational and/or professional background in finance, business, accounting, construction, engineering, real estate, government management or law; and similar experience.
- PFA board members will not receive compensation.
- Up to two (2) PFA public member appointments are presently available.
- Applications must be received by **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday December 15, 2021.**

As required by State and local law, all members appointed to the Public Financing Authority are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests, Form 700 through the California Fair Political Practices Commission. Items that must be disclosed on the Statement of Economic Interests include: interests in real property located within the city limits or within two miles of the city limits, or within two miles of any land owned or used by the City; and investments and business positions in all business entities and income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments from all sources. The Form 700 is a public record subject to disclosure upon request.

The review of applications and selection of new Members will be confirmed by the City Council following an interview process at a publically noticed meeting. In accordance with the Public Records Act, applications and attachments submitted are considered public records and will be disclosed upon receipt of a public records request. While the City will endeavor to protect personal contact information from disclosure, confidentiality cannot be guaranteed.

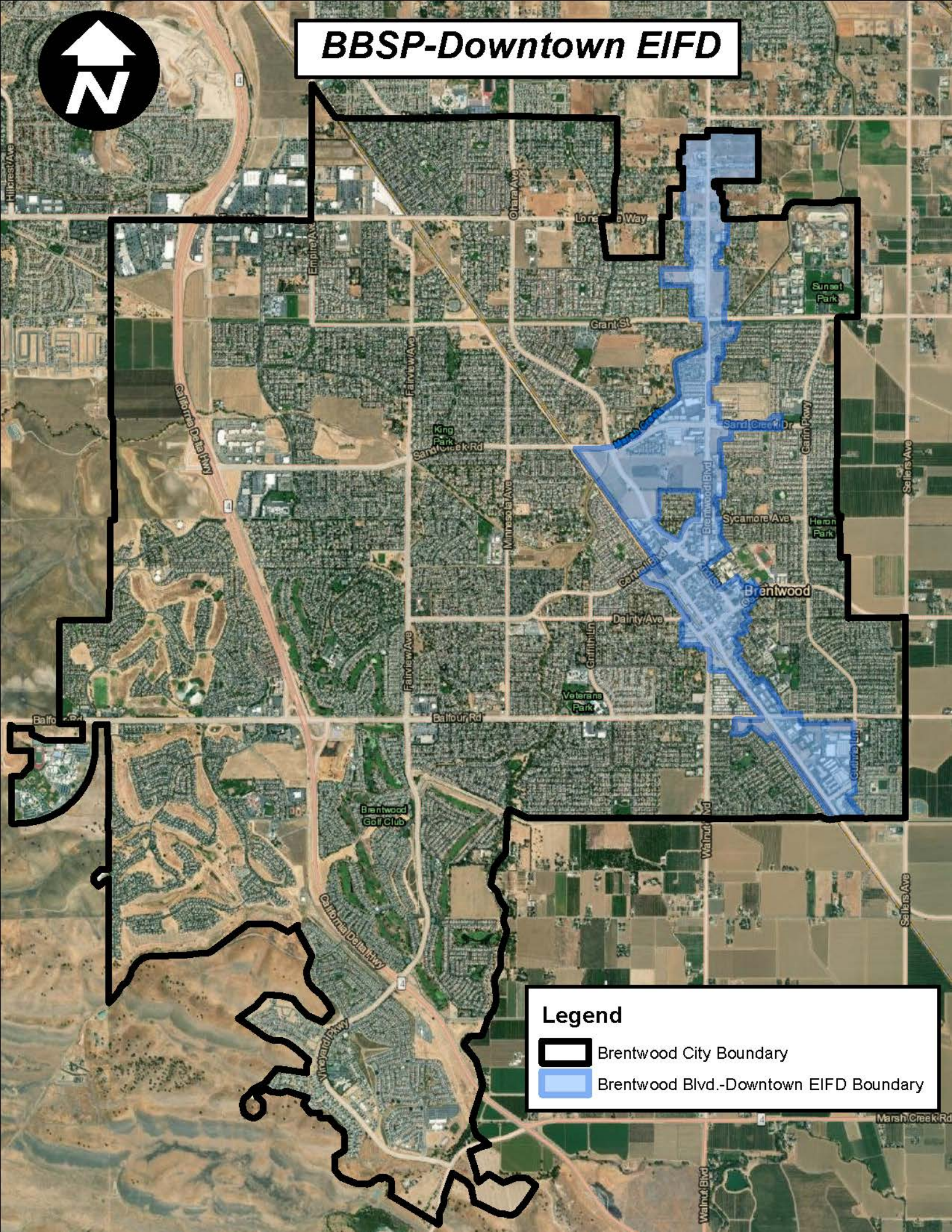

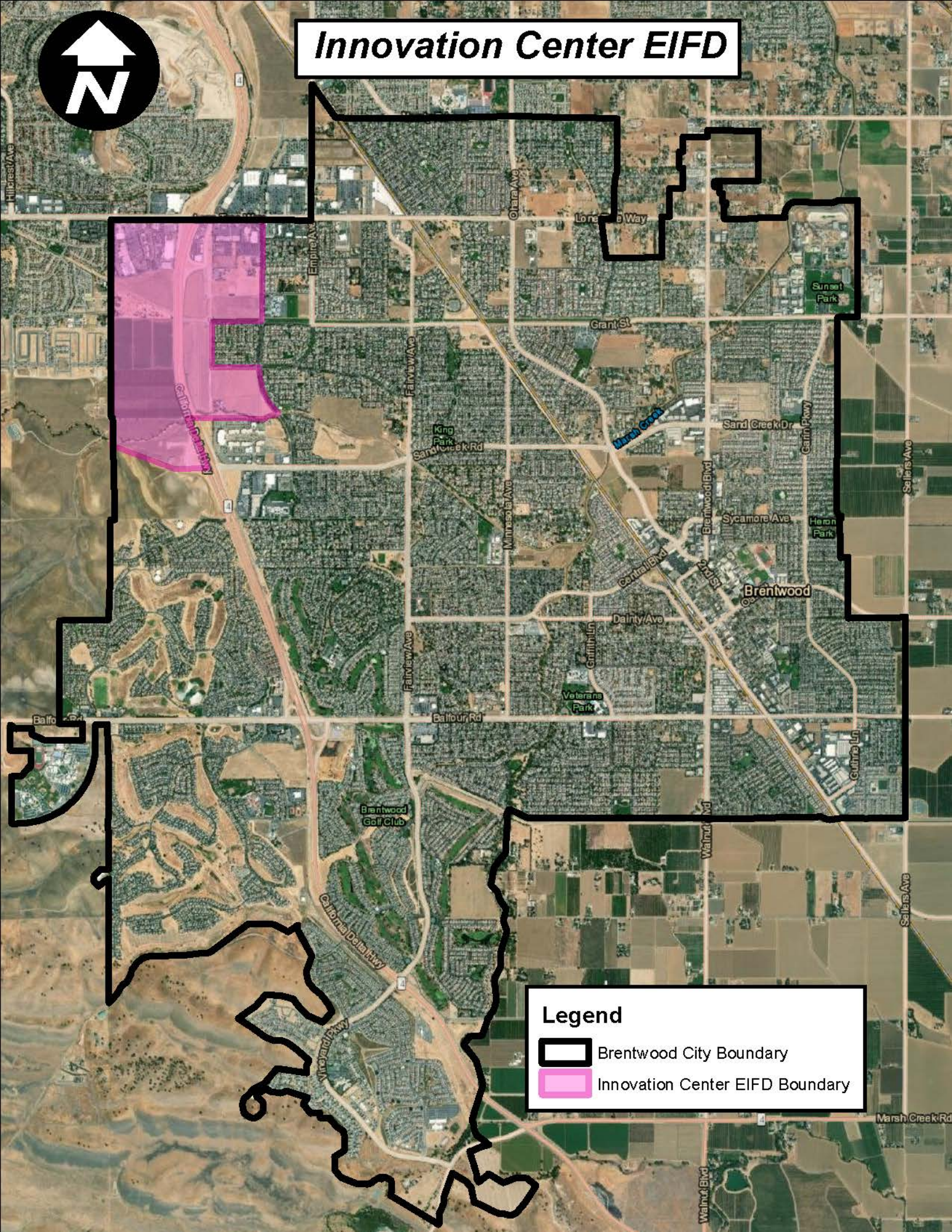
-  Brentwood City Boundary
