



APPLICATION PACKET FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE CITY OF BRENTWOOD REDISTRICTING COMMISSION

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Following receipt of updated population data from the 2020 Census, cities in California with electoral districts are required to update their district boundaries ("redistrict"). With Brentwood's next district elections scheduled to occur on November 8, 2022, the redistricting process must be completed by April 17, 2022.

The City Council has established a hybrid redistricting commission and has transferred all but the last step of the redistricting process to that separate body. When the Commission's part of the process is complete, it will submit two or more potential boundary maps to the City Council, who must then select, without modifying, one of the submitted maps.

- Members of the Redistricting Commission must be available to meet in the evening and, potentially, on some weekends. The first meeting is currently anticipated to be September 9, 2021.
- Applicants for the Redistricting Commission must reside within the city limits and be registered to vote (if not registered to vote, please contact the City Clerk for assistance).
- Redistricting Commission Members are not compensated.
- Five Commission appointments are currently available to be filled, with one member from each of the four current Council Districts, and one at-large member. An alternate may also be appointed from each of the current Council Districts, as augmented by random selection, if necessary.
- Applications must be received by **5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 2, 2021. Applications postmarked, but not received, as of that date will not be accepted.**

As required by State and local law, all members appointed to the Redistricting Commission are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) through the California Fair Political Practices Commission. Items that must be disclosed on the Form 700 include, but are not limited to: interests in real property located within the city limits or near the city limits, or within two miles of any land owned or used by the City; and investments and business positions in all business entities and income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments from all sources. The Form 700 is a public record subject to disclosure upon request.

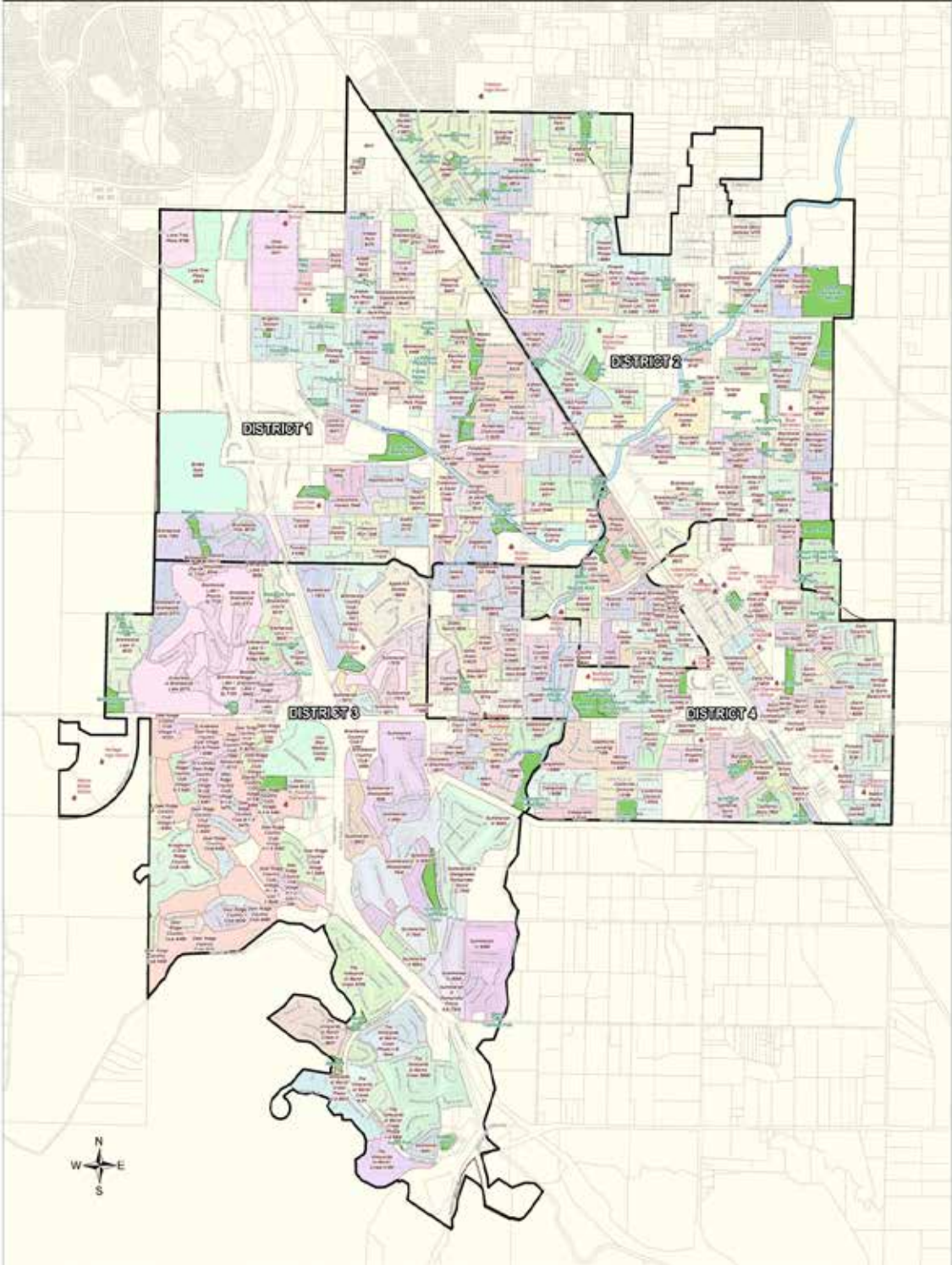

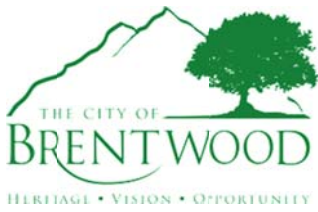

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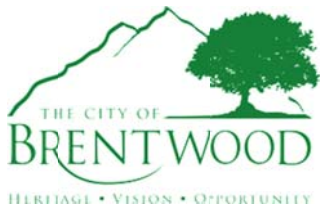

2.	I cannot run for the City Council, or accept an appointment to the City Council, until all of the following requirements are met:	
	a. at least five (5) years has elapsed since my appointment to the Commission; and	
	b. the election for that office will be conducted using District boundaries that were not adopted by the Commission on which I served, unless those District boundaries were readopted after the end of my term on the Commission.	
3.	I cannot accept employment as a staff member of, or consultant to, a City Council member or candidate for four (4) years from the date of my appointment.	
4.	I cannot receive a non-competitively bid contract with the City of Brentwood for four (4) years from the date of my appointment.	
5.	I cannot accept an appointment to any office of the City of Brentwood for two (2) years from the date of my appointment.
