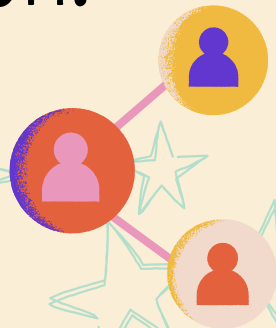

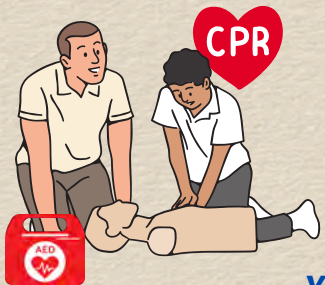
CPR, First Aid, and AED Training

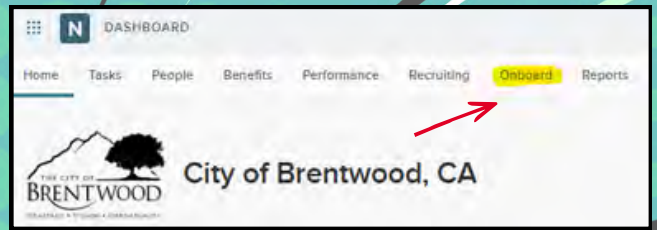

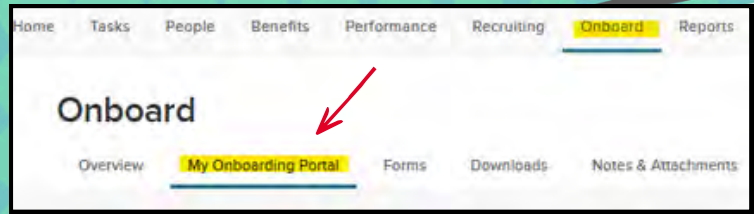
